

1. Open the hood and remove the plastic header panel cover by removing the plastic push fasteners with a small flat blade screw driver (push down on the center of the clip to release, not shown).




Unclip the factory weatherstrip from the bumper cover. You can pull and stretch the weatherstrip off of the mounting clips to release it.




3. Remove the center 10mm bolt (center) and the outer push pins (one per side) retaining the top of the factory grille.



4. Apply masking tape to the perimeter of the grille (as shown) to protect the painted bumper cover during the following factory grille removal procedure.




5. Remove the phillips screw retainers (one plastic, one metal) securing the bumper cover to the metal support (each side).




6. Pull the factory grille out to expose and then remove the upper and lower factory retaining 10mm hex nuts (two per side).




 Once the screws are removed, squeeze the centers of the verticle mounting tabs in and pull the factory grille forward to clear the mounting slots in the bumper cover.




8. Remove the factory plastic push fasteners by lifting up on the center of the pin until it releases, then pull the entire pin straight out to remove.




9. Upon removal of the grille, apply masking tape to the chrome surround to protect the finish.




10. Push on the studs protruding from the back of the factory Lexus emblem to begin the emblem removal.




11. Once the emblem starts to seperate from the insert, turn the insert over and use a squeegee or plastic spreader (do not use a metal screwdriver or pry bar as you will damage the chrome emblem) to finish prying the emblem from the grille insert.



12. Remove the factory plastic push fasteners by lifting up on the center of the pin until it releases, then pull the entire pin straight out to remove. emblem from the grille insert.




 Use needle nose plyers to squeeze and push out the rubber trim clips, removing the factory rubber moulding.



14. Use a flat blade screwdriver to pry out the bottom and side mounting tabs, serperating the insert from the chrome surround.




15. Remove the outer rubber moulding clips and reinsert them into the rubber moulding.



16. Use a die grinder or cut off wheel to remove the alignment tab from the lower inside edge of the factory grille surround. Make sure that it is trimmed flush with the inside edge.




17. Begin the installation of the black edge guard at the upper radiused corners of the factory chrome surround (where shown). Make sure that the longer, tapered edge of the edge guard fits over the visible side of the factory chrome surround.




- ******* IMPORTANT! ****** The exposed edges of the stainless steel mesh can be extremely sharp. Please handle with care. 21
- 21. Align the mesh section over the back of the factory chrome surround.

22. Attach the mesh section to the side mounting plates using the supplied $#8 \times 1/2^{"}$ black truss head screws.




23. Align the top mounting plate and make sure that the outer holes line up with the existing holes in the chrome factory surround on both ends. Install the factory plastic push pins removed in Step 3.




24. Use vise grips or spring clamps to hold the top mounting plate to the inside edge of the factory chrome surround at the center tab (as shown). Make sure that the mesh section is pushed back tight against the top mounting plate. Use a 1/8" drill bit to drill through the existing holes in the top mounting plate and through the factory chrome surround.



25. Install the supplied #8 x 1/2" black truss head screws through the holes drilled in the previous step.



26. Use side cutters to trim the protruding screw tips as flush as you can with the factory chrome surround.




27. Using the supplied double faced tape, cut it into 1/8" wide strips and apply the tape to the outside edge of the emblem (as shown).





28. Peel off the tape backing, align the emblem onto the emblem mounting plate and press firmly to set the tape.


29. Install the emblem assembly onto the mesh grille (make sure it is perfectly centered) using the supplied small black plastic washers, s.s. lock washers and the s.s. hex nuts (not shown).




30. Unbolt the left horn from the radiator support panel (12mm socket wrench) for lower mesh grille hardware installation access.









- 31. Apply protective masking tape to the painted portion of the bumper cover and to the surround "step" of the lower grille insert to protect the finish while aligning the lower mesh grille.
- 32. Align the surround and mesh sections into place and install the supplied black rectangular mesh retainers and #8-32 ESNA half nuts onto all mounting studs. Access the mounting hardware through the upper grille opening. Center the grille and snug the nuts but DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN or you will indent the surround at the stud locations.
- 33. Carefully remove the protective masking tape by pulling back over itself to minimize the tape breaking. You may need to push or pull on the surround if the tape binds under the stainless steel surround.
 34. Reinstall the horn removed in Step 30.



35. Apply the black edge moulding across the inside edges of the bumper cover at all forward facing edges. This will lock the lower portion of the mesh in place one the assembled grille is reinstalled back into the vehicle.



36. View showning mesh grille installed in order to see that the mesh is supported at the bottom by the edge guard.



37. Install the center 10mm hex head bolt (as shown). Install the outer push pins removed in Step 3.





39. Reinstall the factory radiator support panel cover.

38. Remove the factory weatherstrip clips from the bumper cover. Reinstall the rubber weatherstrip back onto the grille and bumper cover by pushing the mounting pins back into the original mounting holes in the chrome surround and bumper cover.
