E&G Classics, Inc. warrants its chrome parts and products to be free from defects in material, workmanship or finish for Twenty-Four (24) months from the date of shipment by E&G. This warranty is limited to the repair or replacement, at E&G Classics option, of the defective part or product.

To obtain performance under this warranty you must:

- 1.) Present your E&G unit to an authorized distributor in your area with proof of purchase.
- 2.) If no distributor is available, contact E&G Classics (address below) for authorization to return unit.
- 3.) Returns All unauthorized returns will be refused. Merchandise approved by E&G for return must have been purchased within the Twenty-Four (24) months. All returns require an authorization number obtained from E&G and the actual return must be accompanied by the written authorization form filled out completely. All merchandise must be inspected upon receipt and shortages reported with in 48 hours. All merchandise must be in a resalable condition. Merchandise must be packed carefully in the original packing. If original packing is no longer usable, repack item(s) comparable to original manner. All returns are subject to a 25% handling charge. Special order items are not returnable. Defective merchandise must have an explanation of the problem. No credit will be issued unless invoice number and date of purchase has been supplied. Manufacturer shall be sole judge of defects in a product.
- 4.) UPS accounts All returns must be prepaid. Do not send return shipments freight collect. Once E&G has made its decision and it is a claim against our warranty policy, E&G will credit incoming freight on damaged parts.
- 5.) No discontinued part or parts changed due to body style are returnable.

IMPORTANT! The exposed edges of the stainless steel grille can be extremely sharp. Please handle with care.



1. Open the hood use a long flat blade screw driver to rotate the exposed mounting clips that retain the upper grille. Turn them approx. 1/8 of a turn and the clips will release.




2. The top two mounting clips on each side that retain the upper grille can be release by pushing in on the side of the clip and pulling straight out. Remove all clips from the radiator support panel.




3. Place the grille onto a clean work surface and remove the left and right air deflectors from the back fo the upper grille by pulling straight out.




- 4. Apply protective masking tape to the factory upper grille (not shown). This will help protect the paint or chrome finish while installing the stainless steel grille sections.
- 5. For "Q" grilles and mesh frames: Peel the protective cover from the stainless steel grille & emblem surrounds and remove the glue residue using solvent and glass cleaner (not shown).
- 6. Align the stainless steel "Q" grille sections or the mesh and stainless steel frames into the factory grille openings and install the supplied black silicone sleeves to hide the mounting studs were visible ("Q" grille shown, mesh same).



7. Align the upper mounting brackets (A) over the studs as shown. Align the large black plastic washers (B) over the studs as shown. Install 8-32 ESNA lock nuts and tighten until snug (Mesh grille shown, "Q" grille same). DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN OR YOU COULD DENT THE STAINLESS STEEL AT THE STUD LOCATIONS!



8. Align the upper mounting brackets (A) over the studs as shown. Align the large black plastic washers (B) over the studs as shown. Install 8-32 ESNA lock nuts and tighten until snug (Mesh grille shown, "Q" grille same). DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN OR YOU COULD DISTORT THE GRILLE OR FRAME!



Remove the factory clips in the radiator support panel and reinstall them into the upper grille. The side clips are different, they feature an extra leg on the clip that must be installed as shown.





10. Remove the factory clips in the radiator support panel and reinstall them into the upper grille.




11. Reinstall the factory air deflectors back onto the assembled upper grille by snapping them back into place.











14. For "Mesh" grille: Install two (2) black silicone sleeves onto each lower mounting stud (trim the ends off with cutters or a razor blade).



15. Align the lower grille (and mesh section) into the opening, making sure it is centered. This is a tight fit to keep the grille locked in place. Install the lower mounting brackets (A), upper small black plastic washers (B) and ESNA lock nuts onto the studs. Tighten until the grill is snug (Mesh grille shown, "O" grille same). DO NOT OVERTIGHTEN OR YOU COULD DENT THE GRILLE!



16. Push down on the bumper cover below the grille and peel off the protective masking tape.

17. Reinstall the front tag bracket.



18. Reinstall the upper grille assembly to finish the installation.
